Skywater over Horseshoe Bay Retains Micheal G. Imber Architects to Design Summit Rock Golf Clubhouse

San Antonio-Based Firm to Create Exclusive Setting for Golfers and Members

Horseshoe Bay, TX – February 17, 2010 – Douglas Jaffe, III, chief executive officer of Horseshoe Bay Resort, announced today that Michael G. Imber Architects of San Antonio has been hired to design the Summit Rock Golf Clubhouse at Skywater over Horseshoe Bay, a 1,600-acre residential community under development in the heart of the Texas Hill Country. Summit Rock, an 18-hole Jack Nicklaus Signature golf course, and the private Clubhouse, will be solely owned and operated by Horseshoe Bay Resort.

“The architecture will be timeless, with European influences, but at once distinctly Texan in character,” says Michael G. Imber, FAIA. “Our desire is to bring together the character of what the Hill Country signifies, what the landscape is, and what it wants to be.”

The Clubhouse design will take advantage of the natural landscape and surroundings, capturing and framing breathtaking views of the golf course, the rugged landscape of the Hill Country, and the spectacular western sunsets. The experience will cater to avid golfers, as well as those members who want to “relax, dine and socialize in the distinctive setting of an exclusive private club,” according to Jaffe.

“Our goal with the Clubhouse is to create an iconic image that speaks to the vision of the entire Skywater development,” said Jaffe. “The finished product will be architecturally substantial: paying homage to the region in a contemporary and meaningful way, while creating a lasting landmark to attract the sophisticated member. We are looking forward to making Imber’s design a reality,” he added.
