ENCHANTED ROCK STATE NATURAL AREA

Enchanted Rock State Natural Area consists of 1643.5 acres on Big Sandy Creek, north of Fredericksburg, on the border between Gillespie and Llano Counties. The Rock is a huge, pink granite exfoliation dome that rises 425 feet above ground, 1825 feet above sea level, and covers 640 acres. It is one of the largest batholiths (underground rock formation uncovered by erosion) in the United States. The park is 18 miles north of Fredericksburg on Ranch Road 965, or from Llano, take State Highway 16 for 14 miles south and then go west on Ranch Road 965. Open Daily 8:00 am-10:00 p.m. Adults 13 - 64 \$6, Children 12 and under free, Seniors \$3.

LYNDON B JOHNSON STATE HISTORICAL PARK

Visitor Center Open 8:00 am to 5:00 pm. Bus tour of LBJ Ranch, 10:00 am to 4:00 pm. Tour is approximately 1 ½ hours and begins at the State Park and includes the one-room Junction school, the cemetery and the Ranch. Adults 18-61 \$6, Children 7 - 17 \$3, Children 6 and under Free.

Visitors can enjoy water-related activities in Inks Lake such as fishing, swimming, boating, sailing, paddle boats, kayaks and canoes. Located nine miles west of Burnet off Texas 29 on Park Road 4. The park is open 7 days a week year round. Camping and entrance fees vary.

This State Park features Longhorn Cavern, a Texas Hill Country wonder created over thousands of years by the dissolving and cutting action of water on the limestone bedrock of the area. Fossil remains show that many Ice Age animals once occupied the cave. On site guides lead you on an hour and a half walking tour covering about 1 ¼ mile round trip through the cavern narrating historical and geological facts. As one of Texas' river-formed caverns, Longhorn Cavern is full of wonderful and exciting discoveries. Picnic areas, hiking trails, gift shop and deli lunch counter.
